Types of NOUN with Examples

1. **Proper Noun:** David, Asia, Sun, Mount Everest, Pacific Ocean
2. **Common Noun:** Men, Country, Mountain, Ocean, Book
3. **Concrete Noun:** Ship, Town, Table, Vehicle, Whale, Wings
4. **Abstract Noun:** Ability, Calm, Death, Faith, Joy, Skill, Sacrifice
5. **Countable Noun:** Apple, Peanuts, Money, Orange, Mouse
6. **Uncountable Noun:** Salt, Sand, Sugar, Water, Meat, Coffee
7. **Compound Noun:** Airport, Classroom, Eardrum, Doorway
8. **Collective Noun:** Colony, Batch, Choir, Organization
9. **Singular Noun:** Bird, Pen, Shirt, Army, Fork, Candy
10. **Plural Noun:** Birds, Pens, Shirts, Armies, Forks, Candies
11. **Possessive Noun:** Dog's, Children's, James's

Proper Noun

A proper noun is a noun that determines the particular person, place, thing, object, organization or any idea which is shown or written in the sentence. This noun begins with a capital letter.

Examples of Proper Noun

- **Person:** Cristiano Ronaldo, Robin, Maria, etc.
- **Place:** England, the United States, Paris, etc.
- **Things:** Apple, Oreo, Pepsi, BMW, Bata, etc.
- **Organization:** World Bank, WHO, UNICEF, etc.

Common Noun

A common noun is a particular name of any person, place, or object.

Examples of the Common Noun

- **Place:** country, state, city, continent, town, village, island, etc.
- **Person:** mother, father, son, sister, friend, baby, child, doctor, etc.
- **Things:** book, desk, water, clothes, toy, car, etc.
- **Idea:** anger, loyalty, memory, honesty, etc.

A concrete noun is a noun that makes a sensible observance and operates as a particular object, person, thing, or anything which we can easily perceive from one of our five sense organs.

A collective noun is a type of noun that expresses a name for a collection of a bunch of several people, objects, things, animals, etc.

A singular noun is nothing but a form of a noun that only represents a singular person, place, idea, or thing.

A plural noun is a noun that represents more than a single person, place, animal, thing, idea, or object.

Possessive Noun

A possessive noun is a type of noun that indicates possession regards any place, thing, idea, object, quality, action, or substance.

Rules for Possessive Nouns

Rule 1:

In singular possessive nouns, we add an apostrophe and “s” after the noun.

- **Andrew’s** car is in the garage.

Rule 2:

In singular possessive nouns which end with s, we add an apostrophe and “s” at the end of the sentence.

- The **boss’s** bike is very expensive.

Rule 3:

In singular possessive nouns which end with s, or even start with “s”, we add an apostrophe and “s” at the end of the sentence. Adding s at the end of the word sounds like hissing.

- **Suhas’** brother is a bodybuilder.

Rule 4:

In the plural possessive nouns which are ended with “s”, then we add an apostrophe after the word.

- **Teachers’** performance is improving by the last time.

Rule 5:

For some irregular plural possessive nouns like group, children, etc., we simply add an apostrophe and “s” after a word for possessiveness.

- The **children’s** shoes are costly.

Example Sentences with the use of Possessive Nouns

1. My **brother’s** laptop is very costly.
2. **Emma’s** new Apple iPhone is the latest version.

4. Unfortunately, I ate the **dog’s** biscuits.

Material Noun

A material noun is a noun that refers to a metal or other substance that is made up of metals or various materials or metallic elements.

Types of Material Nouns

- **Material nouns for plants:** Food, oil, coffee, medicine, perfume, tea, cotton, rubber, etc.
- **Material nouns from animals:** Wool, meat, honey, egg, milk, leather, silk, etc.
- **Materials from nature:** Sand, rock, rain, salt, water, silver, gold, diamond, coal, air, etc.
- **human-made material nouns:** Alcohol, cement, charcoal, cheese, paraffin, cloth, utensil, brick, acid, etc.
