# Pollution



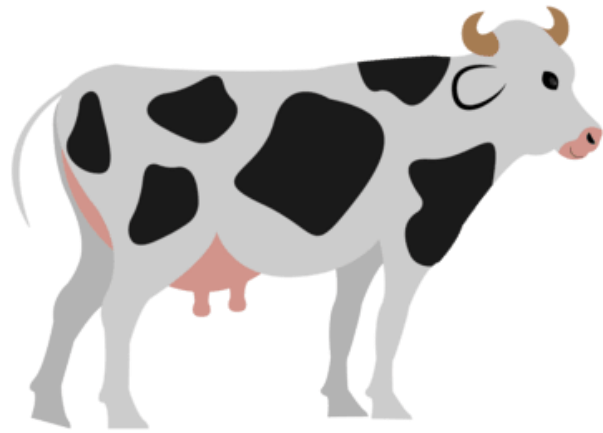
Introduction of alien substances that negatively impact the environment is **Pollution**.

# Cow



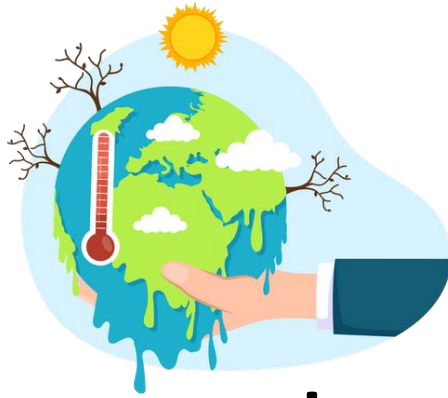
